Patterning involves firing one shot, evaluation your pattern, then going back and firing a second shot. As safety is a priority, those participating will need to have the range focused only on patterning.

What to bring: Turkey hunting shotgun, ammo, targets, target stand, cardboard/newspaper (pizza boxes work great), eye and ear protection. Cardboard from pizza boxes makes excellent backers for this.
