**Treasurers' Report** Checkbook Balance was stated as \$408,856.07. Motion to accept Treasurers report 1<sup>st</sup> Sam C. 2<sup>nd</sup> John B 2<sup>nd</sup> Voted Unanimous

**Buildings and Grounds** - Pat Beland stated office inspected and passed, spackling and painting as well as doors and windows needed. Generator was installed. Pat discussed Rifle Range rebuilding, meeting set up with Ruschinski Hall. Mahoney will need to remove buzzers and cameras. Steel targets had been ordered. Signage of 22 Rimfire only needed.

**Membership** John Bowe stated 779 members and introduced Bob Benway as our new Membership Chair.

**By Laws** Sam Christianson scheduled Saturday the 21<sup>st</sup> as next meeting for By Laws and Constitution.

**Archery** Pat Beland discussed the 3D range. @ bridges were needed, one had been constructed, he invited volunteers Friday at 6:30 am to join him behind the 200 yard berm as the range opened at 9pm.

**Conservation Council** Dan Ladd spoke of The Gore Mountain Fishing Derby. 40 had attended and caught some 13-18 inch rainbows. Dan spoke of two crossbow laws stating limb width and max speed. A Dove Hunting Bill was held for consideration.

**Smokeless Range** Steve Supolski stated he was seeking reservations with groups of 5 for 1 hour each. No reservation's currently.

**New/Old Business** John Bowe spoke regarding the 200 yard range improvements as well a shotgun patterning station. John stated he had the Insurance up to date most noteworthy was general liability was up \$1000. John spoke of updating our software so that we could be collecting more data on our ranges and to see who was coming through the gate. Updating would cost \$1400.
