Treasurers Report:

Building Use

Classes being held at the club. People are making money on this. Club wants to set up a policy to charge people for holding classes. Charge \$10 per head or a percentage based on the class cost. Mahony is no longer taking care of the camera's. Shane is ordering 8 new camera's to figure out what will work. Entire range has wifi all the way out and there will be 32 cameras throughout the property. Back up for cameras can hold data for 2 weeks. We need to get hard drive for the cameras. Shane is in charge and has control of cameras at this time.

Decision made to set up a Budget committee. We need to set in place by month/yr a budget of income and known expenses. Leslie, Sam John B and Dennis offered to commit.

Projects committe will be Sam, John and Nick.

We decided on a new cleaning company,

The pistol area is very sloppy. Drain pipes, stones needed approx. 2 ton for the back area. Need a \$ amount. It will be under the \$2,500 limit - cost Need Nick to measure back berm for matt.

Motion for \$2,000 for drain and seed for the back. Sam motion second John B Vote Unanimous

Leslie stated our CD is maturing. We will roll it over for a 6 mth period at 3.5% 1st John B 2nd Pat

Kathy brought up that we should probably change the door code key as it has rarely been changed and there is change in BOD.

Sam brought up the Thur closed range and does it need to be revisited. At this time we will put up new signs: Range closed Thursday. A new sign for the gate that would have range phone number/ burner phone # . We will remove the Range open signs.

Mar 14 Pat received a quote for the parts to repair the gate. It is \$568, does not include shipping. He said that we could repair ourselves. I make a motion that we OK the purchase of the gate materials up to \$800. Pat has a debit card and can purchase it as soon as we approve. 2nd John B Various communication that we are getting a quote to repair/replace from a reputable gate company as we do not know the seriousness of the damage and as this should be covered by Utica National the ins. Co of the individual who damaged the gate we should make sure all our bases are covered.

Mar 15

The debit card bank account needs to have money transferred into to bring the balance back up to the \$5,000 limit.

I, Leslie Richard, make a motion to allow me the Treasurer to transfer \$3,500 from the operating checking account to the debit card checking account. 2nd Nick V. unanimous vote

Mar 16 Just want to make everyone aware of this before I purchase SurveyMonkey's annual account. I'm not sure why but if I were to pay for SurveyMonkey through the Android App on my phone it's 399.99/yr versus \$468/yr plus taxes if it's paid for through the website. Normally that's a no brainer but if it's paid for through the App then the account is billed through and connected to my personal Google Play account which is inconvenient to say the least and certainly inappropriate. If everyone is good with the extra \$68, I'll finish paying for our account through the website and then get the vote regarding the garage out to the members this week. I'll also get the account information to those of us who have JoinIt access since it is linked to the Club's JoinIt account.
